

2nd Saturday Age Requirements

In order for youth ages 5-17 to participate in 2nd Saturday they must have a parent or legal guardian complete and turn in our 2nd Saturday Liability Consent and Release form (see 2nd page for form). This form is good for one calendar year and it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to update emergency contact as needed throughout the year by emailing the Local Outreach Assistant, Brittany Jenco, at bjenco@gfconline.com. In addition, volunteer leaders are not responsible for the care of other volunteers' children and we ask that you follow the requirements listed below:

- Ages 5-12 – must be accompanied by a parent/guardian **at all times**
- Ages 13-15 – must be accompanied by any adult serving at the same event
- Ages 16-17 – can serve without a parent/guardian/adult

14. In-House – ages 5-17 (recommended)
